**ORDER**

On February 24, 2023, the Office of Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, by Rachael L. Fletcher Cipoletti, Chief Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, in accordance with Rule 3.25 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, presented to the Court its petition praying for the Court to accept the annulment of the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Amanda B. Godwin. The petition further requests that the Court dismiss, as moot, the pending Statement of Charges in Supreme Court Docket No. 22-813. The formal affidavit, under seal, of the respondent consenting to voluntary disbarment was filed on February 27, 2023.

Upon consideration and review on April 20, 2023, the Court does grant the petition. It is ORDERED that, pursuant to Rule 3.25 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent Amanda B. Godwin is annulled by voluntary consent.
