On a former day, to-wit, September 13, 1985, came the Committee on Legal Ethics of the West Virginia State Bar, by Robert H. Davis, Jr., its attorney, and presented to the Court its motion in writing to dismiss or suspend the hearings on the petitioner's petition for reinstatement to the practice of law in West Virginia filed August 7, 1985, for the reasons stated therein. And came also, Richard F. Pence, pro se, and presented his reply to the motion to dismiss or to suspend hearings. Upon consideration whereof, the Court is of opinion to grant said motion. It is therefore considered and ordered that the petition for reinstatement be, and the same is hereby, dismissed.
