At a Regular Term of the Supreme Court of Appeals continued and held at Charleston, Kanawha County on the 9th day of September, 1985, the following order was made and entered, to-wit:

On a former day, to-wit, August 5, 1985, came the Committee on Legal Ethics of the West Virginia State Bar, by Robert H. Davis, Jr. and Linda Gay, its attorneys, and after reviewing the reports of Dr. Donald S. Swick, Clinical Psychologist and Dr. Thomas Knapp, Psychiatrist, filed with the Court on July 26, 1985 presented to the Court its motion in writing for a disability suspension, with certificate of service. Upon consideration whereof, the Court is of opinion to sustain said motion.

It is therefore considered and ordered that the license of the respondent, Roy S. Samms, Jr., to practice law in the State of West Virginia be, and the same is hereby, suspended indefinitely, effective September 9, 1985.
