On a former day, to-wit, October 31, 1991, came the complainant, the Committee on Legal Ethics of The West Virginia State Bar, by Sherri D. Goodman, its attorney, and the respondent, George D. Beter, by Thomas W. Smith, his attorney, and presented their joint motion in writing to the Court confirming the respondent's compliance exceeding the original recommended sanction of an eighteen-month suspension and recommending a final sanction wherein the respondent reimburse the Committee on Legal Ethics of The West Virginia State Bar for the costs incurred in the investigation of the above-captioned proceeding in the amount of One Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$1,661.60). It is further considered and ordered that the respondent, upon compliance with the final sanction, shall no longer be prohibited from the practice of law. Justice Neely absent.
