

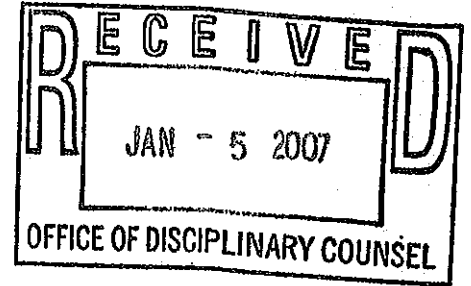

The Court, having maturely considered the record, the written recommended disposition filed by the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, and the brief of counsel thereon, doth hereby annul the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Leonard S. Coleman, for violating Rule 8.4 of the Rules of Professional Conduct. It is further ordered that the Respondent make restitution to Goodwin & Goodwin in the amount of \$170,740.00, less any payments previously made, at a rate of 10% interest per annum, and that the Respondent reimburse the Lawyer Disciplinary Board for the costs of these proceedings in the amount of \$481.62; all of which is ordered to be certified to the parties herein.

The syllabus of points adjudicated, prefixed to the written opinion aforesaid, prepared Per Curiam, was concurred in by Chief Justice Davis and Justices Starcher, Maynard, Albright and Benjamin.


