

On a former day, to-wit, March 9, 2007, came the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by Rachael L. Fletcher Cipoletti, its attorney, pursuant to Rule 3.25 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, and presented to the Court its petition seeking the annulment of the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Lafe P. Ward, Jr., and the formal affidavit of the respondent consenting to voluntary disbarment.

Upon consideration whereof, the Court doth hereby grant the aforesaid petition. It is therefore ordered that, pursuant to Rule 3.25 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Lafe P.
