



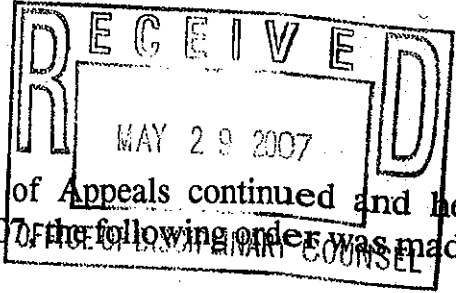

In the Matter of: Petition for Reinstatement of Michael F. Niggemyer to the West Virginia State Bar


