On a former day, to-wit, March 17, 2005, came the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, by Rachael L. Fletcher, its attorney, pursuant to Rule 3.27 of the West Virginia Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, and presented to the Court its petition seeking the immediate administrative suspension of the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Carolyn Sue Daniel, a member of The West Virginia State Bar, and that another lawyer be appointed to serve as trustee to protect the interests of respondent's clients.


Upon consideration whereof, the Court is of opinion to and doth hereby grant said petition. It is therefore ordered that the respondent's license to practice law in the State of West Virginia be, and it hereby is, suspended pursuant to Rule 3.27 of the West Virginis Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure.

It is further ordered that the Honorable Gray Silver, III, Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of Berkeley County, be, and he hereby is, authorized to appoint an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of West Virginia to act as a trustee to protect the interests of respondent's clients.
