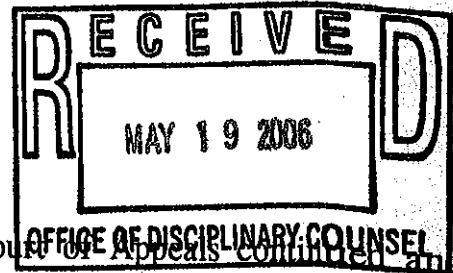


Steven L. Miller, a suspended member of The West Virginia State Bar, Respondent
