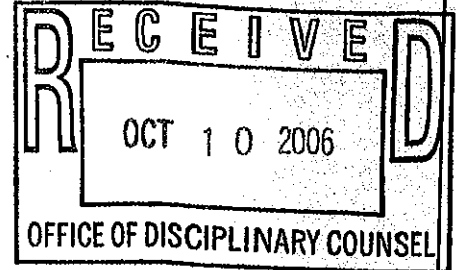


STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA


