

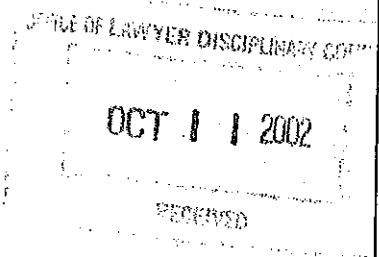

The Court, having maturely considered the record, the report filed pursuant to Rule 3.27 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, and the oral argument and brief of counsel thereon, doth hereby temporarily suspend the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Glenn M. Nichols, pending the outcome of all underlying disciplinary proceedings against the respondent. It is further ordered that the order entered by the Honorable James C. Stucky, Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of Kanawha County, appointing an attorney to oversee the affairs of the respondent's clients, shall remain in full force pending the outcome of all underlying disciplinary proceedings against the respondent; all of which is ordered to be certified to the parties herein.

The syllabus of points adjudicated, prefixed to the written opinion aforesaid, prepared Per Curiam, was concurred in by Chief Justice Davis and Justices Starcher, Maynard, Albright and McGraw.
