On a former day, to-wit, January 4, 1995, came the the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by Stephen G. Jory, its attorney, pursuant to Rule 3.10, Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, and presented to the Court its written recommended disposition recommending that a public reprimand of the respondent, Nelson R. Bickley, a member of The West Virginia State Bar, issue.
