

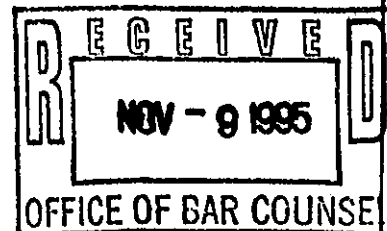

At a Regular Term of the Supreme Court of Appeals continued and held at Charleston, Kanawha County, on the 6th day of October, 1995, the following order was made and entered:

The Court today handed down a prepared order finding sufficient evidence to warrant further investigation of the allegation by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel of The West Virginia State Bar presented to this Court pursuant to Rule 3.23(a) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, on the 4th day of August, 1995. It is therefore ordered that the respondent, David R. Karr, Sr., (1) undergo an evaluation under the supervision of Wayne H. Dickinson, M.S.Ed., CCDC-III, of Martins Ferry, Ohio (614-633-2056), to ascertain the respondent's capacity to continue in the practice of law, with a report of the evaluation submitted to the Office of Disciplinary Counsel; and (2) have his law practice supervised by a lawyer selected by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel in the manner prescribed by said office. It is finally ordered that the Hearing Panel of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, no later than six months after Mr. Dickinson's report is received by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, conduct a properly noticed hearing during which the panel shall consider the evidence in the Office of Disciplinary Counsel's report and any additional evidence including, but not limited to, the medical report and the supervised practice report(s) in order to make a recommendation to this Court concerning the respondent's alleged disability and whether such disability warrants an administrative suspension of the respondent's license to practice law in the State of West Virginia.

Service of a copy of this order upon the respondent and all parties herein by certified mail, return receipt requested, shall constitute sufficient notice of the contents hereof.
