On a former day, to-wit, August 17, 1995, came the petitioner, William E. Kiger, by Joseph M. Brown, his attorney, pursuant to Rule 3.32, Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, and presented to the Court his petition for reinstatement. Thereafter, on the 26th day of September, 1995, pursuant to this Court's order entered on the 17th day of August, 1995, and pursuant to Rule 3.32(b), Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, came the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, by Sherri D. Goodman, Chief Disciplinary Counsel, and presented to the Court its report and recommendation, recommending that the law license of the respondent be reinstated effective on the 16th day of October, 1995.

Upon consideration whereof, the Court is of opinion to and doth hereby adopt the aforesaid recommendation of the Office of Disciplinary Counsel. It is therefore ordered that the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, William E. Kiger, be, and it hereby is, reinstated effective on the 16th day of October, 1995. Justice Albright deemed himself disqualified.
