ORDER

On October 25, 2021, the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by its Chair David A. Wandling, in accordance with Rule 3.10 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, filed its written recommended disposition in this matter, recommending that:

- (1) Respondent's law license be annulled.
- (2) Respondent comply with the mandates of Rule 3.28 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure; and
- (3) Respondent be ordered to pay the costs of these proceedings pursuant to Rule 3.15 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure.

On November 10, 2021, the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, by Andrea J. Hinerman, Senior Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, filed its consent to the recommendation. The respondent did not file a consent or an objection to the recommendation.

Upon consideration, the Court is of the opinion to and does concur with and approve the recommended disposition of the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board. It is ORDERED that:

- (1) The license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, David E. Furrer, is **annulled**.

(2) Respondent shall comply with the mandates of Rule 3.28 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure; and

(3) Respondent shall pay the costs of these proceedings pursuant to Rule 3.15 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure.
