ORDER

On October 27, 2017, the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by Timothy E. Haught, its chairperson, pursuant to Rule 3.10 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, presented to the Court its written recommended disposition in this matter, recommending that: (1) respondent's law license be annulled; (2) respondent be ordered to comply with the mandates of Rule 3.28 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, and also be directed to promptly surrender all papers and property in his possession to which his former clients are entitled; and (3) respondent be ordered to reimburse to Lawyer Disciplinary Board the costs of these proceedings.

Thereafter, on November 16, 2017, the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, by Renée N. Frymyer, Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, filed its consent to the recommendation. The respondent has not filed a consent or an objection.

Upon consideration and review, the Court is of the opinion to and does hereby concur with and approve the recommendations of the Hearing Panel Subcommittee.

It is therefore ORDERED that: (1) respondent's license to practice law in the State of West Virginia, shall be, and it hereby is, **annulled**; (2) respondent is directed to comply with the mandates of Rule 3.28, Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure; (3) respondent is directed to forthwith surrender all papers and property in his possession to which his former clients are

entitled to the Trustee Webster J. Arceneaux III; and (4) respondent shall pay the costs of these proceedings pursuant to Rule 3.15 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure.

Service of a copy of this order upon all parties herein shall constitute sufficient notice of the contents herein.
