ORDER

On March 24, 2021, the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by Stephen M. Mathias, its chairperson, in accordance with Rule 3.10 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, presented to the Court its written recommended disposition in this matter, recommending that: (1) the respondent be reprimanded in accordance with Rule 3.15 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure; and (2) respondent be ordered to pay the costs of these proceedings in accordance with Rule 3.15 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure.

It is ORDERED that the respondent, Harry W. Moore, Jr., is **reprimanded** for his misconduct in this matter.
