

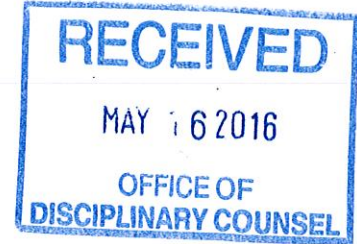
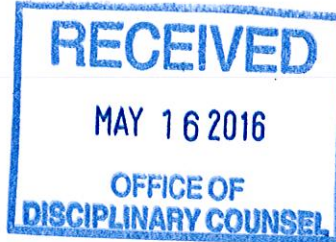

MANDATE

Pursuant to Rule of Appellate Procedure 26, the opinion previously issued in the above-captioned case is now final and is hereby certified to the Lawyer Disciplinary Board and to the parties. The respondent's license to practice law is hereby suspended for a period of ninety days, following respondents suspension, the respondent's practice be supervised for a period of two years by an attorney agreed upon between the ODC and respondent; that the respondent meet with her supervising attorney every two weeks with the goal of the supervised practice being to improve the quality and effectiveness of the respondent's law practice to the extent that the respondents sanctioned behavior is not likely to recur; that the respondent refund the \$5,000 retainer fee to Ms. Wright-Ochoa immediately; and that prior to being automatically reinstated, the respondent pay the costs of the disciplinary proceeding in the Wright-Ochoa/Brown case and the Greynolds case, and the respondent is hereby ordered to reimburse the Office of Disciplinary Counsel for the costs of this action in the amount of \$2,013.72. The Clerk is directed to remove this action from the docket of this Court.
