MANDATE

Pursuant to Rule 26 of the Rules of Appellate Procedure, the signed opinion issued in the above-captioned case is now final and is certified to the Lawyer Disciplinary Board (Case Nos. 21-03-363 and 22-03-255) and to the parties. The Court imposes the following sanctions on the respondent: (1) The respondent's law license be suspended for a period of three years served retroactively based upon the Supreme Court's Mandate of March 14, 2022. The respondent's law license shall not be reinstated before March 14, 2025; (2) that the respondent's petition for reinstatement pursuant to Rule 3.32 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure be denied until he undergoes a psychological evaluation with confirmation of his ability to practice law. Should he be reinstated to the practice of law pursuant to those proceedings, that the respondent's practice be supervised for a period of two years by an attorney agreed upon by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel and the respondent; (3) the respondent shall pay the costs of this disciplinary proceeding pursuant to Rule 3.15 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure in the amount of \$861.69. The Clerk is directed to remove this action from the docket of this Court.
