**ORDER**

On July 31, 2023, the petitioner Jeffry H. Hall, by counsel John H. Tinney, Jr. and John K. Cecil, Hendrickson & Long, PLLC, filed a petition seeking to voluntarily resign as a member of the West Virginia State Bar in accordance with Rule 3.26(a) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure. On December 6, 2023, the Investigative Panel of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by its Chair C. David Morrison, filed its written report in accordance with Rule 3.26(c) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, recommending that the petition be denied.

Upon consideration and review on April 10, 2024, based on the specific circumstances of this proceeding, the Court is of the opinion to and does grant the petition to voluntarily resign from the West Virginia State Bar. Justice Walker and Justice Bunn would grant the petition on the condition that the petitioner pay his past bar dues.

It is ORDERED that the petitioner Jeffry H. Hall has leave to voluntarily resign from the West Virginia State Bar. It is finally ordered that the petitioner shall comply with the client notification requirements of Rule 3.28 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, if applicable.
