ORDER

On May 24, 2023, the Office of Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, by Rachael L. Fletcher Cipoletti, Chief Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, in accordance with Rule 3.25 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, presented to the Court its petition requesting the Court accept the annulment of the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Kenneth Brian Adkins. The formal affidavit, under seal, of the respondent consenting to voluntary disbarment was filed on May 25, 2023.

Upon review and consideration on June 7, 2023, the Court does grant the petition.
