MANDATE

Pursuant to Rule of Appellate Procedure 26, the opinion issued in the above-captioned case is now final and is hereby certified to the Office of Disciplinary Counsel and to the respondent, Kevin E. McCloskey. The court imposed the following discipline on the respondent: a public reprimand; a five year prohibition on respondent's opportunity to apply for admission to practice law in West Virginia, including *pro hac vice* admission; a five year prohibition on respondent's appearance in any court in West Virginia; if respondent should ever seek admission to the West Virginia State Bar, he first obtain twelve hours of continuing legal education in law office management and/or legal ethics; and the respondent is hereby ordered to reimburse the Office of Disciplinary Counsel for the costs of this action in the amount of \$4,724.13. The Clerk is directed to remove this action from the docket of this court.
