ORDER

On February 9, 2024, the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by its Chair Timothy E. Haught, pursuant to Rule 3.20 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, presented to the Court its written recommended disposition in this reciprocal disciplinary action, recommending that the same sanction that the State of Maryland issued be imposed.
