ORDER

On September 19, 2019, the petitioner, Ronald D. Hassan, a suspended member of the West Virginia State Bar, filed a petition for reinstatement of his license to practice law in the State of West Virginia under Rule 3.32 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure.

Thereafter, on September 20, 2019, the Office of Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, by Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel Jessica H. Donahue Rhodes, filed its report, in accordance with Rule 3.32(b) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, recommending that the petitioner's license to practice law be reinstated without a hearing. The petitioner filed his consent to the recommendation on September 23, 2019.

Upon consideration and review, the Court is of the opinion to and does hereby adopt the recommendation and the petition for reinstatement is granted. It is therefore ordered that the petitioner, Ronald D. Hassan, shall be, and he hereby is, reinstated to the practice of law in the State of West Virginia.
