**ORDER**

On April 1, 2019, the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by Elizabeth Layne Diehl, its chairperson, pursuant to Rule 3.20 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, presented to the Court its written recommended disposition in this reciprocal disciplinary action arising from the discipline imposed by the District of Columbia Court of Appeals. The Hearing Panel Subcommittee recommends that: (1) the respondent's license to practice law in the State of West Virginia be suspended for a period of sixty (60) days with automatic reinstatement; and (2) the respondent pay the costs of this proceeding pursuant to Rule 3.15 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure.

Upon consideration, the Court is of the opinion to and does hereby concur with and does hereby approve the recommendation disposition of the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board. It is therefore ORDERED that: (1) the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Seth A. Robbins, shall be, and it hereby is, suspended for a period of sixty days with automatic reinstatement pursuant to Rule 3.31 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure; and (2) the respondent shall pay the costs of this proceeding pursuant to Rule 3.15 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure.

Service of a copy of this order upon the respondent, Seth A. Robbins, the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, and the West Virginia State Bar shall constitute sufficient notice of the contents herein.
