On June 25, 2020, the petitioner, Travis C. Sayre, a suspended member of the West Virginia State Bar, in accordance with Rule 3.32 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, filed a petition for reinstatement of his license to practice law in the State of West Virginia.

On August 18, 2021, the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by its Chair Timothy E. Haught, in accordance with Rule 3.32(c) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, presented to the Court its written report and recommendation, recommending that the petitioner's license to practice law in the State of West Virginia be reinstated with the condition of a period of supervised practice for two years with an attorney in good standing with the West Virginia State Bar who actively practices in the geographical area in which petitioner practices..

The respondent, Office of Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, by Rachael L. Fletcher Cipoletti, Chief Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, filed its consent to the recommendation on August 26, 2021. The petitioner did not file a consent or an objection to the recommendation.

Upon consideration of the recommendation from the Hearing Panel Subcommittee, the Court is of the opinion to and does adopt the recommendation and the petition for reinstatement is granted with certain conditions. It is ORDERED that the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the petitioner, Travis C. Sayre, is reinstated subject to the condition of supervised practice for a period of two years with an attorney in good standing with the West Virginia State Bar who actively practices in the geographical area in which petitioner practices.
