On March 5, 2018, the petitioner, William P. Hagenbuch, Jr., filed a petition seeking to voluntarily resign as a member of the West Virginia State Bar in accordance with Rule 3.26(a) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure. On February 17, 2021, the Investigative Panel of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by its Chair Amy C. Crossan, filed its written report in accordance with Rule 3.26(c) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, recommending that the petition be granted.
