On a former day, to-it, October 14, 2011, came the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by David A. Jividen, its chairperson, pursuant to Rule 3.20 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, and presented to the Court its written recommended disposition in this reciprocal disciplinary action, recommending that in light of the Supreme Court of Ohio's acceptance of respondent's disbarment by consent, the respondent's license to practice law in the State of West Virginia be annulled.

Upon consideration whereof, the Court is of opinion to and doth hereby adopt the written recommended disposition of the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board. It is therefore ordered that James R. Henry's license to practice law in the State of West Virginia shall be, and it hereby is, **annulled**.
